St. Xavier's Academy School was reopened on the month of June 10, 2024. Everyday School starts functioning with a morning assembly. At Present, there are 210 Students Studying in the School and 23 Teaching Staff. There are 16 spacious well furnished classrooms, Science lab, Math Lab, Computer lab and Library. Students are taught with Smart Board.
